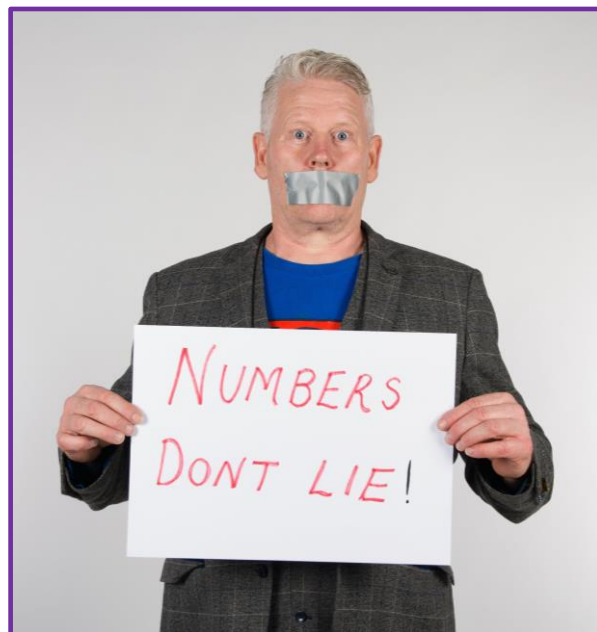

4. Arrows

Arrows are natural strengths or challenges contained in a person's **birth chart**.

You simply superimpose the persons date of birth on the 1 – 9 number grid shown below. Here's an example using Stephen birthday **30/12/1964**;

3	6	9
2	5	8
1	4	7

Blank number grid

3	6	9
2	5	8
1	4	7

Highlighting all the numbers in Stephen's birthday

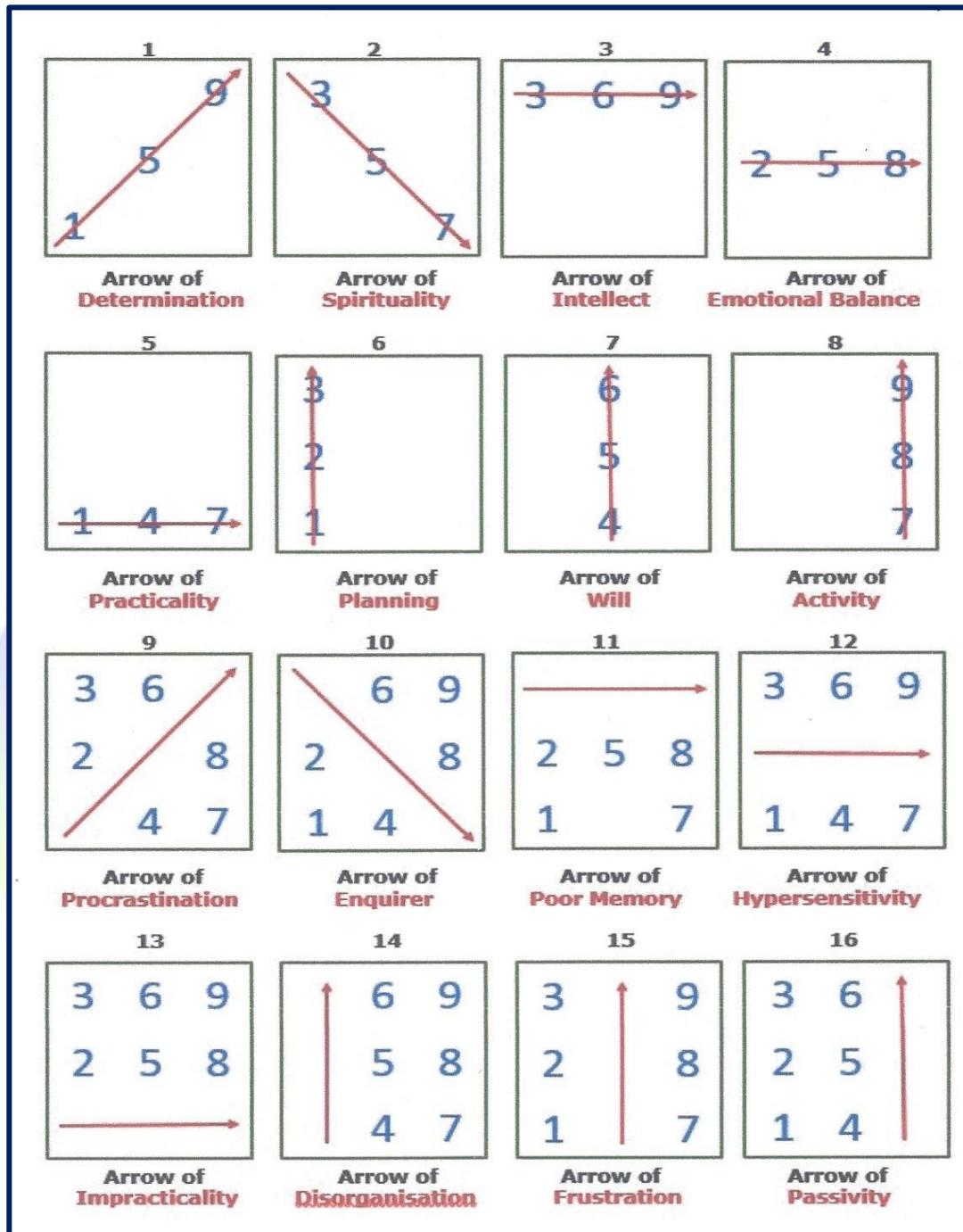
3	6	9

Connecting the arrows (any 3 numbers or blanks in a line)

An arrow is depicted when 3 numbers or 3 blank spaces from the chart line up vertically/horizontally or diagonally. You can see on Stephen's birth chart he has 2 arrows '123' and '369.'

There are **16 potential arrows**. Not everybody has arrows, the most you can have is 6 (very unusual), most people tend to have 1 or 2. Here's what they mean;





The label under each one gives you a basic idea what each one means; you can deduce from the name that the top half (1 – 8) are perceived more as strengths and the bottom half (9 – 16) tend to be more challenge based.
